For people living on the margins We pray for those persons living on the margins of society, in inhumane life conditions; may they not be overlooked by institutions and never considered of lesser importance.







Pray for us, that we may commit ourselves selflessly to doing the same charitable acts that you did all your life. Amen












Thoughtful Thursday 28th September 2023 – Feria The 25th Week of Ordinary Time- Year A

- 4 Ask forgiveness for the moments when I have fallen short.
- 5 Look forward to tomorrow and ask where I need God in the day to come. Give thanks.
