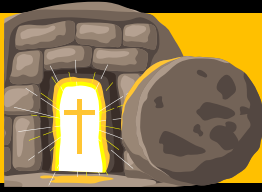

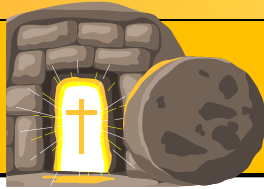

Reflect silently on the Globe. Pray for the Lord to pour out His peace on our hearts, homes and world.

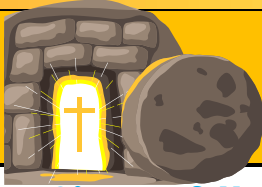

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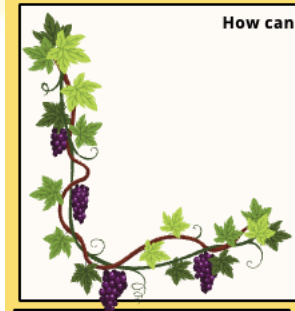


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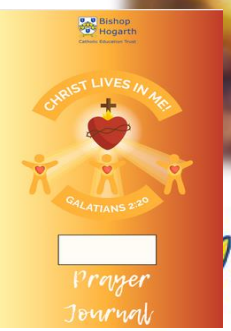
